Windows are an important element in how a home looks and how it works. From a design point of view particular styles of windows are suited to particular styles of homes. For example Federation homes typically have casement windows, French doors and double hung windows. More modern homes typically have sliding windows, fixed glass and bi-folds.

Windows are the opening to the outside world and play a vital role in transmitting light into the dwelling and heat energy into and out of the house. They also play a vital role in controlling the flow of breeze into the dwelling and the prevention of water from entering. Different windows do different things. For example casement windows are ideal for controlling the flow of air into a home while awning windows let you have airflow even if it is raining lightly.

Choice of glass is vital in determining how a window performs. You are able to control heat loss or gain with the right choice of glass. You are also able to create a more secure environment using laminated glass as well reduce outside noise. You can also control light and glare using particular glass. Windoor manufactures a full range of

standard windows. However unlike other manufacturers we do not just make standard sizes. Windows from Windoor are made to your exact sizes.

In addition to the standard windows we are able to manufacture virtually any special window design or configuration you require. If you are renovating or extending a period home we are also able to match the existing windows for you. We can manufacture fly-screens for all the window options.

If you are painting the windows Windoor is able to prime your windows in preparation for on-site painting. This will save time on-site while giving you a better over all finish. The windows are primed before assembly and glazing and this means no little nooks or crannies are missed.

All windows that are to have a natural finish are treated by Windoor with a water repellent so that they can remain on site for up to six weeks and will not stain if they get wet in that time. The subsequent coats of stain go straight over the water repellent.
